DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Agitate contents well before use.

Use appropriate personal protective equipment and handling equipment. Before tank mixing, jar test all added nutrients for compatibility using mixing instructions.

Fill tank to a minimum of two thirds with water.

Add other nutrients as prescribed under agitation.

Add BioAg Digest-it under agitation and bring volume up to full.

Use water rates of a minimum of 75 to 100 litres per hectare.

Use within 48 hours of dilution.

Rinse tanks and sprayer and flush lines after use.

TYPICAL APPLICATION RATES

Applied via Boom Spray, Fertigation or Aerial Spray

CROP	RATE	COMMENT
Broad Acre Cereals and Pulses	2 to 4 L/ha	Apply to moist soils and incorporate residues within the aerobic zone of the soil with 48 hours, preferably with an offset disc.
Vegetables	3 to 6 L/ha	
Horticulture	3 to 6 L/ha	Can be applied via irrigation.

NOTE: The rates suggested above should be used as a guide only. Each farmer's climatic conditions, water quality and farming practices may differ and thus require alterations to these rates to achieve optimal results.
